Limerick City : City Mayors and Councillors To May 29th Meeting. The Mayors and Councillors of the Limerick City Council have been advised of and are therefore present at the meeting of the Council held this day at 10.00 a.m. Dáil Éireann Resolution 45/2005 Amending the Oath. Amending the Oath of Allegiance in Ireland. The Dáil adopted a resolution today to remove the Oath of Allegiance from the Constitution of Ireland and to have a public referendum on the matter. This was discussed in the Dáil by Minister for Justice Charlie Flanagan who informed the House that he will introduce An Act to Amend the Constitution with regard to the Oath of Allegiance, known as the Constitutional Referendum Bill. The Bill would allow the Irish people to make a referendum on the matter. Deputies expressed concern about the basis for this change, and concerns about the effect of this change on the Constitution as it is currently construed. "There is no authority for this change anywhere in the Constitution. It is a matter for the Oireachtas." Speaker of the Dáil, Cormac Ó Cuív T.A. The House also discussed other matters of interest. Convening in the Dáil. Deputy Jimmy Keane TD speaking on behalf of the Green Party, said: "The response of the Government to the financial crisis has been lacking, and the economy is in a tail-spin. There are so many areas of policy that have been neglected, that this is a welcome opportunity for Government to get out of its comfort zone. It is wrong of Government not to scrutinise the issue of the oath. There are so many examples in history where loyalty was withheld from people because of an oath." Minister for Justice Charlie Flanagan, responding to Deputy Keane's remarks said: "The Government have been accused by the opposition of a lack of scrutiny of policy issues. Well as far as the administration of justice is concerned, it would be audacious for anyone to claim that it has not been scrutinised.
